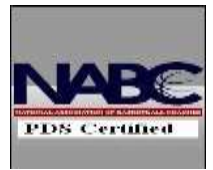

## HIGH SCHOOL Info Spring/Summer 2019

**Purpose:** Help players receive exposure & assist in developing REAL options for possibility of playing beyond high school. Goals:

- ⇒ Provide **EXPOSURE**: (in particular for 16U/17U levels) to college coaches via certified events and through our vast network of contacts and recruiting assistance capabilities
- ⇒ Develop players to be able to handle practice levels 2 grade levels beyond their current grade
- ⇒ Prepare players to play well in June period with their high schools, as well as next school year
- ⇒ Provide support/assistance in off-court areas, including academically to help ensure a qualifier (core GPA & ACT score), as well as core life skills needed in college recruiting/application process

### PROGAM COMPONENTS

#### Competition/General Schedule

**SPRING:** 4-6 tournaments. 1-2 NCAA Certified tournaments as allowed in April. Some tourneys local, some regional (Indy, Cincy, Nashville, etc)

**JUNE - NO ACTIVITY** for HLB from last tourney until 7/1. Players play with their high school teams until June 25<sup>th</sup>, which is start of Ky dead period – runs through July 9<sup>th</sup>.

**SUMMER/JULY live period:** 2 OR 3 NCAA Certified tournaments during live periods 7/1-7/30

**NOTE: Spring & Summer are different seasons-players may/may not play both**

**Practices:** 2 per week avg during spring. NO practices spring break week. Before spring break practices are often clustered around weekends to make it easier on our out of town players

#### Support Areas

ACT Prep & Academic support sessions & Recruiting Assistance workshop for parents are among the support services included with High School AAU participation

### PARENT INFORMATION SESSION for High school

**ALL** players must have a parent/guardian attend a parent Information meeting – or watch it on Facebook Live -- where all details of program, including how to register for NCAA rosters, how we handle travel and program costs are covered. Players will NOT be allowed to tryout until this is completed.

### PAST RESULTS/SUCCESS of High School Team Program

Since 2008, HLB has had 85 players move on to play at the college level (at 37 different schools in 15 states) & 175+ players move onto the high school level in KY, IN, OH, and FL. In that 10 year period, those players have netted over \$2,220,000 in both athletic scholarships and academically related financial aid.
